Key

- 1 Future Shared Use Path along E. Valley Springs Road (**green**). Private internal trail system should connect at multiple points to this larger regional path.
- 2 Festival Street for a portion of Raleigh Street - designed as a "shared" street to allow ped/bike traffic a safe/protected route
- 3 Private internal trail system (**pink**). Proposed shared-use paths and/or hiking trails, designated as non-biking or with signage providing to right-of-way to pedestrians.
- 4 Designated trail crossings across roads, hierarchy of crossing options to be determined with road design:
 - Basic striped crosswalk
 - Raised crosswalks ("tables")
 - Rapid flashing signalized crosswalks
 - Pedestrian underpasses (potentially only one across Chronicle)
- 5 Off-site golf cart path to follow future sewer line easement to Esmeralda Golf Course (**blue**). Internal golf cart circulation to be on-street.
- 6 Private internal trail system to connect outward to regional trail system wherever feasible. Signage will be needed to indicate transition to private system.
- 7 Existing off-site mountain bike trails to remain (**orange**). County to provide new regional connection on south end (dashed)
